The Springfield Crappie Club held its fall meeting on January 24th at eagles club in Riverton. President Dan Runkel called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

OFFICER REPORTS

Treasurer Catalano gave the end of year (December 31st, 2009) financial report. He reported we have \$4,362.83 in our CD. Our checking balance is \$1919.87 and the savings balance is \$22.24. The current checking account balance is \$419.67. He also reported a \$2500 profit from the buddy tournaments in 2009. Late fees collected at the buddy tournaments made the club \$600.00, all going to the Classic payouts.

Secretary Mike Shipman read the minutes from the previous meeting and they were approved by the members present.

Tournament Director Jerry Jallas said we had 11 boats at both the Springfield and Clinton club tournaments, 15 boats at Mark Twain and 13 boats in the Classic.

Vice President Bales reported the club by-laws are being reviewed. Not for content, but to clean them up and realign the structure of the document. The amendments will be copied up to the item they are amending and the original item will be lined through. The amendment page will still be the last page of the by-laws.

President Dan Runkel thanked our members for helping the officers through out the past year, he thanked our sponsors at B&M poles and our web sponsors. He also welcomed our new members who joined in '09. Lastly, Dan presented the Angler of the Year Jackets to Wes Pierceall and John Tisdale. Congratulations guys!!

OLD BUSINESS

President Runkel asked the membership for their feelings concerning late payment of our annual club dues. Membership overwhelmingly agreed the by-laws state the due date is the last day of February each year and we should not accept payment for the dues (currently \$20) from anyone without an additional payment of the initiation fee which is currently \$15.

By-Law amendment – Membership voted 23 to 1 to require an initiation fee to be collected with the annual dues payment for any member paying dues after the last day of February each year. They also agreed there will be no exceptions
